NATO Contracts ATCO Frontec to Support Up To 10,000 Troops In Kandahar

Experience, Expertise Cited as More Than 350 Workers Required to Provide Services at Afghanistan Airfield

CALGARY, Alberta – ATCO Frontec has been awarded five contracts to provide multiple support services for up to five years at the Kandahar Airfield in Afghanistan for the more than 10,000 troops serving NATO's International Security Assistance Force.

"ATCO Frontec has the experience and expertise to deliver high quality support to the NATO mission in Afghanistan," said Harry Wilmot, President, ATCO Frontec. "We consider this a key opportunity to further showcase our operational capabilities and to enhance our support of the NATO forces—including the Canadian Forces contingent." The contracts, which will require ATCO Frontec to deploy more than 350 trained personnel, include airport disembarkation operations, infrastructure, utilities and support services, as well as pest control.

Specific sectors of responsibility include fire and crash rescue, visiting aircraft cross-servicing services, roads and grounds maintenance, facility maintenance, construction, engineering, equipment and vehicle maintenance, aircraft movement control and terminal transport, accommodation services, supply operations, airfield mechanical transport, delivery of potable water, sewage management, and waste management and disposal.

These contracts, with start dates in August and September, were awarded by the NATO Maintenance and Supply Agency after a significant competitive tender process and will contribute to the sustainability of upwards of 10,000 international troops based at the Kandahar Airfield. Transition activities have already begun and will require immediate deployment of more than 350 personnel to Kandahar.

ATCO Frontec continues to bolster its experience in the provision of support to military operations worldwide. With current assignments in Kabul, Kosovo, and Bosnia – and prior commitments throughout the Balkans, in Cape Verde, Africa and Pakistan, the company's expertise has grown exponentially since entering this industry more than seven years ago.
